## **Discussion Items:**

- A. Wrap Up Discussion of 2013 Goals: Devon has researched a question that came up at our last meeting, as to whether the Williams Kindig House is currently under any kind of "lease to own" contract with the current residents. It is not. She has also arranged to have various local recycling centers listed on our EAC page. We have some locations that have not yet gotten back to us, but their information will be added as soon as we have it.
- B. Earth Day Plans: On Earth Day Devon has arranged for collections to be available for motor oil, and old appliances. Shredding will also be available, and there will be a concerted effort to clean up the Nature Center. We will also plan to plant a tree and place a plaque in honor of Charlotte Dubroff and her work for the Township's environmental causes.
- C. Recycling Electronic Devices: Jim O'Byrne provided the group with material on Pennsylvania's Covered Device Recycling Act which requires consumers and businesses to recycle computers, monitors, printers, etc. The EPA has determined that electronic waste is the fastest growing source of municipal solid waste, and many electronic devices contain valuable metals such as gold, silver and platinum and base metals like copper, iron and aluminum that can be separated and reused in new products. There is an app (iRecycle) available for your iPad, iPhone, iPod touch, and Android.
